BEGINNER CLASSES - Beginner riders are restricted to beginner classes **ONLY**. Horse to be ridden in legal AQHA approved head gear (eg. snaffle, hackamore, curb bit), **CAN BE RIDDEN TWO HANDS**, no tie downs or training gear as per AQHA rule book, saddle good working order, western saddle not required. Rider - long sleeve shirt, boots, hat or safety helmet. Beginner rider is to have no more than 3 wins with 5 or more horses in the class.

All junior horse, senior horse, amateur, novice & youth classes will require correct head gear for age and will need to be shown in western saddle as per AQHA rules. All **SENIOR HORSES** (6 years & over) in these open classes are required to be shown **ONE HANDED IN A CURB BIT**.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

- * **AQHA rules apply** - It is the responsibility of each competitor to complete entry details correctly and all owners and riders of registered Australian Quarter Horses must be financial members of the AQHA if points are to be recorded.
- * For all registered Quarter Horse and AQHA members a copy of your current AQHA membership/amateur cards and QH registration papers will be required with nominations.
- * **OPEN HORSES CAN ENTER EITHER RANCH RIDING OR WESTERN PLEASURE - NOT BOTH. BEGINNERS ARE WELCOME TO ENTER BOTH CLASSES.**
- * **YOUTH IN RIDDEN AQHA CLASSES MUST BE 7 YEARS - 18 YEARS OF AGE AS AT 1ST AUGUST OF THE PRECEDING YEAR.**
- * The committee reserves the right to cancel or combine any event with insufficient entries.
- * The judges decision is final
- * **Liability** - QQHA will take no responsibility for any loss, damage or theft to any persons/horse, vehicles or property while at this show. All competitors compete at their own risk.
- * A marshaling yard will be provided and all competitors in the events following the current one being judged must be marshaled five minutes prior to the commencement of the event.
- * Every horse competitor must have filled out a Horse Health Declaration Form.
- * In case of EI virus outbreak the CSASS will not be responsible for any costs incurred or monies lost by an outbreak of EI to a competitor, spectator or volunteer.
- * **Refund Policy** - if the show is cancelled a full refund/credit will be given
- * **Refunds** - definitely no refunds after closing date unless accompanied by a current medical or vet certificate. Nomination refunds will only be given when show secretary receives appropriate certificates within 7 days of the event being held.
- * **Beginner classes** - Beginner riders are restricted to beginner classes only. Horse to be ridden in legal AQHA approved head gear (eg. snaffle, hackamore, curb bit), can be ridden two hands, no tie downs or training gear as per AQHA rule book, saddle good working order, western saddle not required. Rider - long sleeve shirt, boots, hat or safety helmet.
- * Beginner rider is to have no more than 3 wins with 5 or more horses in the class.
- * **Back Numbers** - back numbers will be allocated per horse and must be displayed when competing. No back number or incorrect back number NO placing.
- * **All AQHA open classes** - senior/junior horse, amateur & youth - will be run under AQHA rules. Western equipment and attire is mandatory for these classes. Senior horses (6 years and over) must be rode one hand in a bit.
- * Dogs must be on a leash at all times.

CODE OF CONDUCT

No alcohol is allowed in or can be consumed in the marshaling areas, working areas or show pen/contestant areas. Competitors/participants at any event run by CSASS have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion. Competitors/participants are to conduct themselves in a professional manner and act with integrity in all dealings with CSASS and other competitors. To uphold the rules and regulations of CSASS and demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event must have written permission from their parent/guardian to be at that event as a contestant or participant and in the case of a contest, the parent/guardian must also sign the entry form. All youth competing or taking part in an AQHA approved event must be in the care of a responsible adult who is in attendance for the duration of that event, whilst the youth is in attendance at that event.
